REGISTRARS REPORT 03/09/08.

From the Report received from H.Q. dated 01/09/08 the Membership & Licence situation is as follows,

Membership

National 23338, North West 2650, (904 Gold, 1413 Silver, 333 Bronze.) 2112 Senior, 90 Junior, 252 Youth, & 243 Under 12. There are 593 NEW Members in the Total, and the Gender Split is 2305 male, 392 Female. The National CLUB Membership is 74%, whilst ours in the North West is 71%.

Licences.

1356 have been issued to date (31 Elite, 43 First, 96 Second, 286 Third, 443 Fourth, the youths are split :- 137A, 102B, 95C, 69D, & 54E.) Further analysis reveals that the Ladies hold 175 of these licences, whilst The Under 23's have 88, and Juniors have 75.

Comparing September 2007 with the current figures shows that National membership has a 13.8% growth, and a 9.6% increase in Racing Licences.

I have not received any notifications for new Clubs since my July report.

North West Region is the THIRD largest behind Scotland (3024 Members.) and South East (2990 Members.)

However we have issued the SECOND highest number of Licences beaten only by South East (1804.)

I anticipate that the HUGE success of the National Team at the Olympic Games will create a further rise in Membership during the rest of 2008, and into 2009.
