



**Road Workgroup  
Report for AGM  
24 August 2021**

The continuing effects of the Covid-19 pandemic has stilted our progress somewhat during the course of this last year.

However, this has given us an opportunity to assess our current offering (pre-pandemic) and look at how we can enhance the future offering in more detail.

In particular, the data we have available suggests that work is needed to increase our offering to our membership in the south of the Region, and we had hoped to promote a road race on a new course in Wrenbury, Cheshire this season. Unfortunately, the chosen date clashed with an alternative event in the same locale, which resulted in us having to postpone the use of this course. We will be actively recruiting an organiser for this course in the next month or so, as we are keen for road racing to be resurrected in Cheshire.

We are also reviewing our calendar allocation process to ensure that we have the right number of opportunities at the right levels across the Region. This is due to be discussed at our next Road workgroup meeting.

Finally, the Regional Road Race Championships have been set for Sunday 10 October 2021 on Bashall Eaves (long circuit), which is being organised by the Regional Board.
